Magische Quadrate sind schon sehr lange bekannt. Das älteste bekannte magische Quadrat geht auf den Kaiser Yu zurück, der ungefähr um 2200 v. Chr. in China gelebt hat. Das ist allerdings nur eine Legende, zeigt aber, wie die faszinierenden mathematischen Eigenschaften der magischen Quadrate die Menschen schon seit Jahrtausenden beschäftigt haben.
